**Amendment to the Hancock County Clean Air Regulation**

At a regular meeting of the Hancock County Board of Health on Tuesday, April 21, 2015, the Board members reviewed and amended the Hancock County Clean Air Regulation of 2014. The amendment re-defines "Enclosed Area" (Section 1002. Part d) The amended definition is available for a 30-day public notification period beginning April 27, 2015. A copy to the amendment is available for public review on the Hancock County Website and in person, during normal business hours, Monday through Friday from 8am-4pm at the Hancock County Health Department in New Cumberland, WV. It is also available at the Mary H. Weir Public Library in Weirton; the Swaney Memorial Library in New Cumberland; and the Lynn Murray Memorial Library in Chester. 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### **SECTION 1002. DEFINITIONS**

The following words and phrases, whenever used in this Regulation, shall be construed as defined in this section:

- a. "Business" means any sole proprietorship, partnership, joint venture, corporation or other business entity formed for profit-making purposes, including retail establishments where goods or services are sold as well as professional corporations and other entities where legal, medical, dental, engineering, architectural or other professional services are delivered.
- b. "Employee" means any person employed by an employer for direct or indirect monetary wages or anything of value, or any person who volunteers for a non-profit entity.
- c. "Employer" means any entity or person who employs the paid or volunteer services of one or more persons.
- d. "Enclosed Area" means all space between a floor and ceiling which is enclosed, that is bounded on at least ~~two~~ **three** sides by walls, doorways or windows, whether open or closed. A wall includes any retractable divider, garage door, or other physical barrier, whether temporary or permanent and whether or not containing openings of any kind.
- e. "Healthcare Facility" means an office or institution providing care or treatment of diseases, whether physical, mental, emotional, or other medical, physiological, or psychological conditions including but not limited to, hospitals, rehabilitation hospitals, weight control, laboratories, offices of surgeons, chiropractors, physical therapists, physicians, dentists and all specialist within these professions. Healthcare facility includes all waiting rooms, hallways, private rooms, semiprivate rooms, and any adjacent outdoor property under its control.
